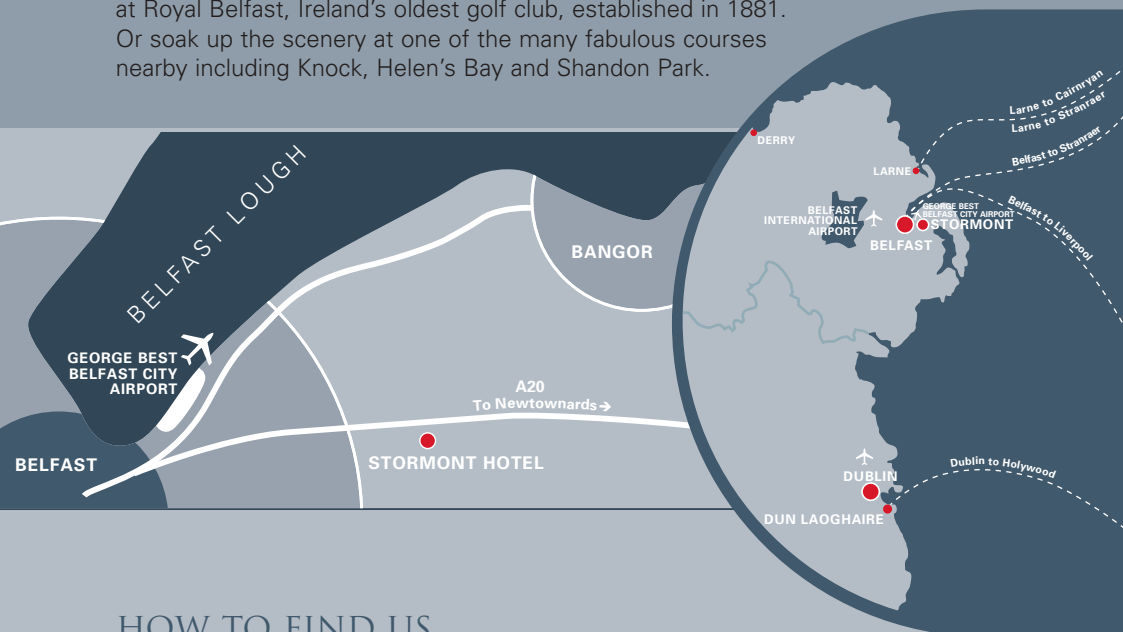




WITHIN PITCHING DISTANCE OF MANY FINE GOLF COURSES
